The student – teachers were not very happy with the arrangements made for the drinking water. They wished that the water from mineral water plant should be supplied upstairs. The water supply in the bathrooms was also unsatisfactory. The students wished that, there should be a canteen in the campus so that, the day scholars from nearby villages get benefited. The previous batch students (2008-2009) expressed their displeasure regarding the work load in the second term of the year. As a result of it, the present batch 2009-2010 batch had their teachings and internship in the first term itself. Hence the students felt a great relief in the second term.

The students were happy with the teaching of the faculty members. The English Methodology students wished that they should be supplied with notes as they hail from Telugu Medium background. The lecturers concerned felt the need and decided to prepare and supply notes atleast for the important topics. The students were not very happy with the computer practicals and language lab activities. The students also desired to have games period atleast once a week. Much has to be done to include those aspects in the regular time table.

As far as internal tests are concerned, the students asked for one exam a day

instead of two. This has to be planned for the next academic year.

The M.Ed's are also quite happy with the course, faculty and the facilities. They were provided with much access to the library and other facilities as per the requirement.
