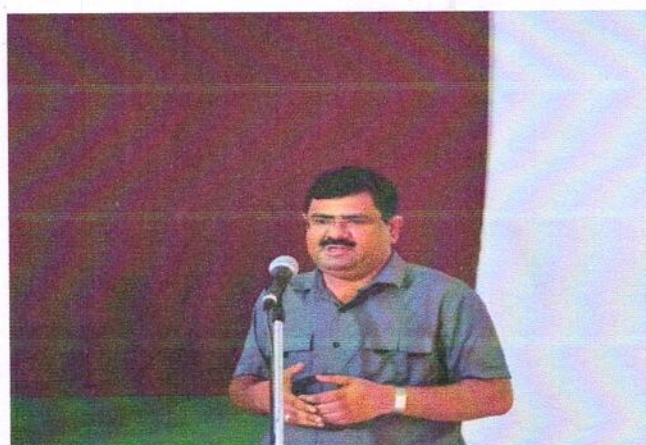

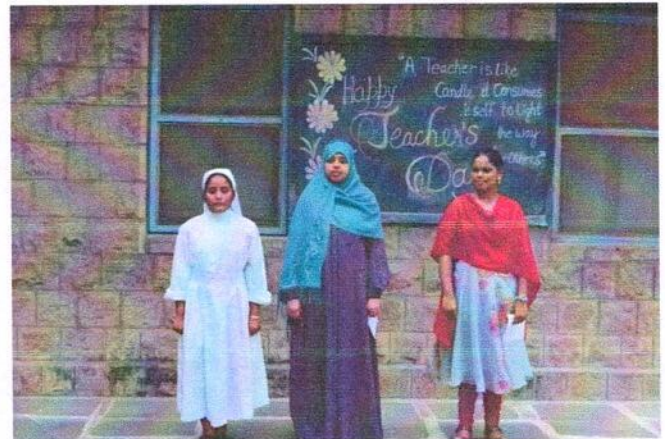

St. Joseph's College of Education for Women, Guntur celebrated the feast of Saint Mathias Wolff - the Founder of the Congregation of JMJ, the Management on 31-10-2022. To give glimpses of his life, a power point presentation was given from which the Staff and Students were enlightened and inspired.

Mathias was born to Mathias Wolff and Anna Maria Zenner on 6th March 1779 in Diekirch, Luxemburg. He was brought up in an atmosphere of 'Kindness always and severity when necessary'. Later Mathias was ordained as a Diocesan Priest in 1802 and totally dedicating himself to God in the service of others. The impact of French Revolution affected him adversely. It moved and prompted Fr. Mathias to take some initiatives towards Education of the girls. So, he thought of encouraging willing girls to join hands to bring the change in the society. Thus, Fr. Mathias Wolff decided to start a Women Congregation to educate the poor girls and to reach out to those in need.

The first three girls he started with were Maria Stichters, Sophie Miltner and Lubuina van Elck. He got them trained, and they professed as catholic Nuns and later a new Congregation for Women was founded on 29th July 1822, in Amersfoort, and named it as the Society of Jesus Mary Joseph (JMJ). And the rest is the present scenario we know the JMJ Congregation renders a great deal of service both nationally and internationally in various fields of which Education, Health and Social service being the prominent ones.

## SEMINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND ROLE OF EDUCATION

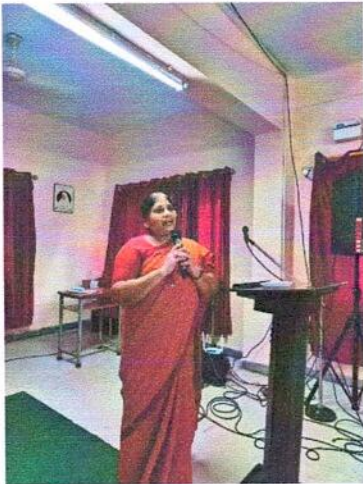

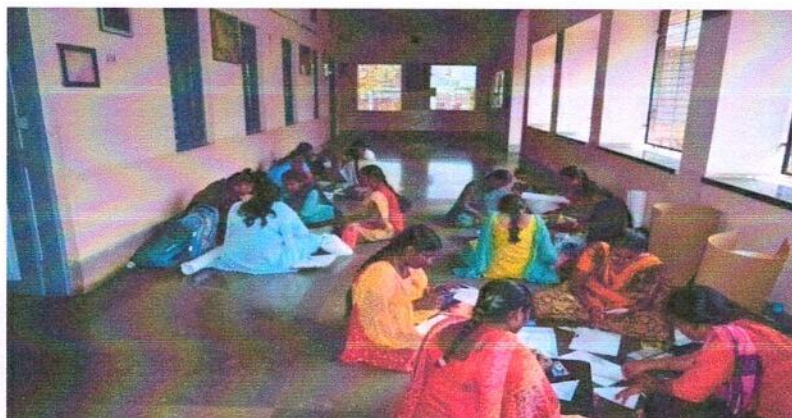

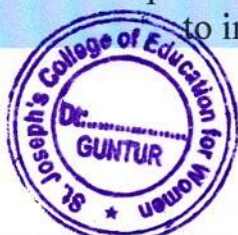

This webinar provided valuable insight into what works on education and helps to inform evidence-based practice and policies.

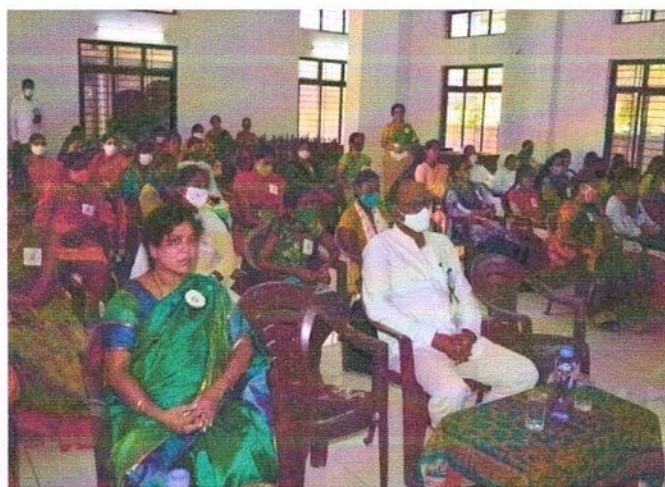

The outcome of the programme: Commitment to Unity in action, together to achieve.



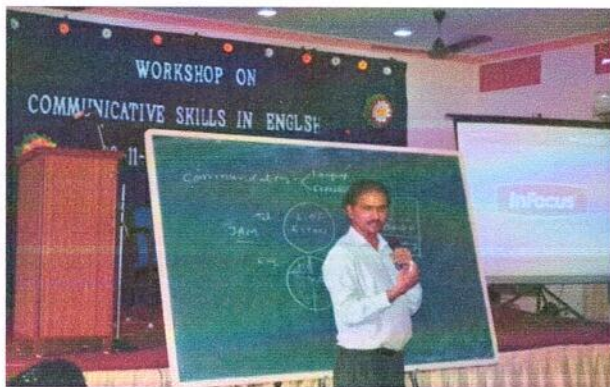

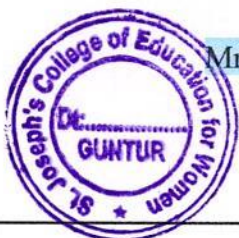
