**Objective:** To extend helping hand and to make them happy and relaxed.

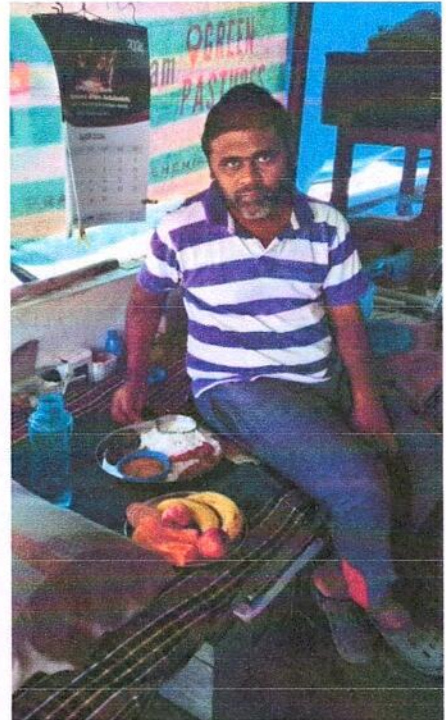
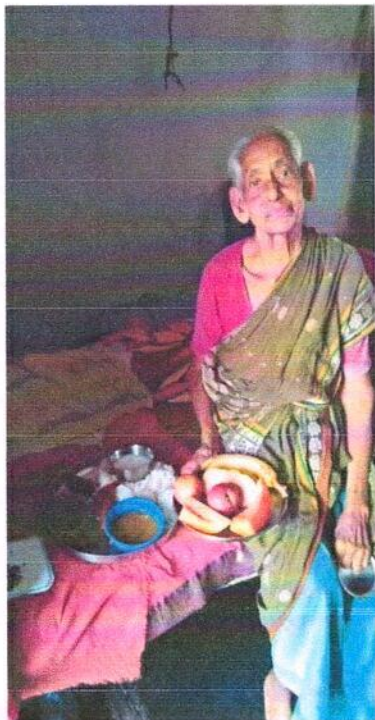

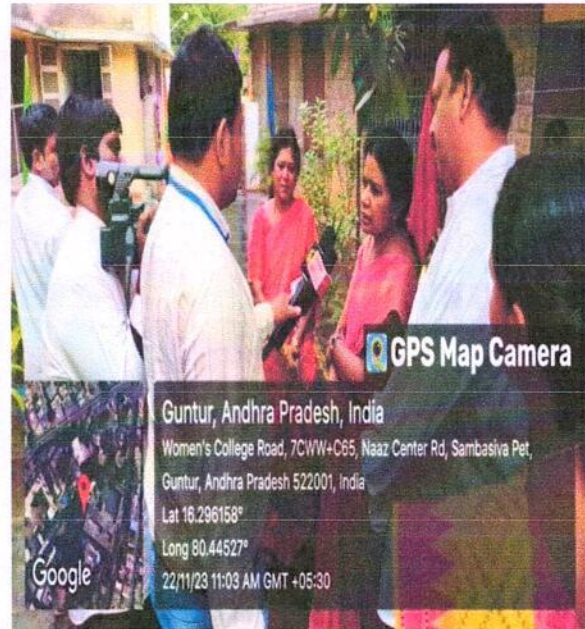
## Conducting blood donation camp

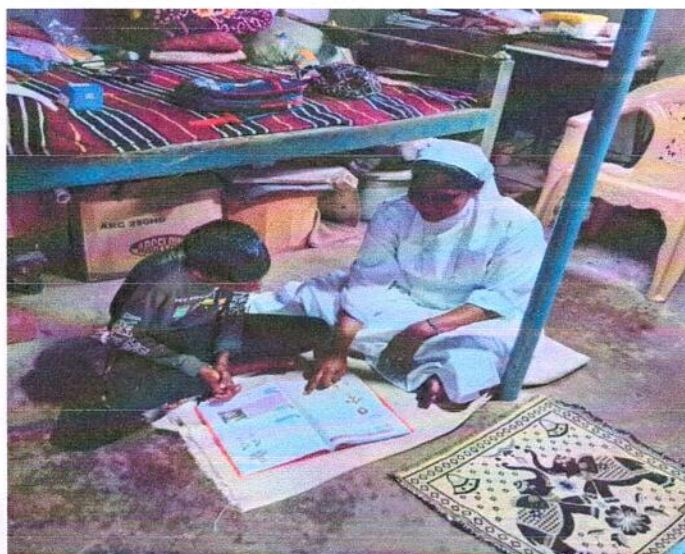
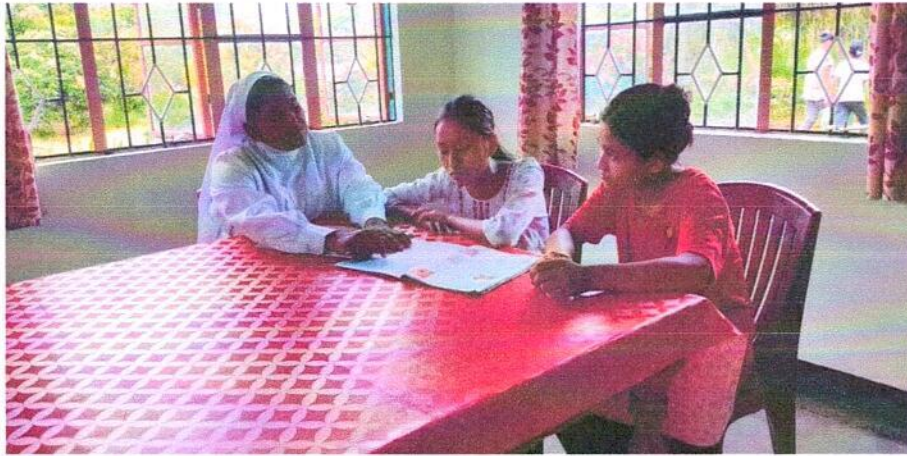
## Liberating the Illiterates with Each one teach one - Initiative

### Activities Undertaken During Epidemic COVID -19

During the COVID-19 pandemic, educational institutions faced unprecedented challenges, but many rose to the occasion by conducting various extension activities to support the communities and contribute to the fight against the virus. These activities, often driven by a sense of social responsibility, aimed to provide relief, awareness, and education to those affected by the pandemic. As a part of this our SJCE too, stood in forefront to extend support to the community in the following ways.

The SJCE Management and staff have distributed Rs.25, 000 worth of food provisions to 185 families who are daily waged laborers' and homeless. On **4<sup>th</sup> April**, the provisions Rice 5Kg, Dahl – 1 kg & Oil Kg packet were packed in 90 Bags for **90 families**. We went Uppalapadu village which is 10 Km away from Guntur town and distributed in person in collaboration with Sr. Denin & JMJSSS team.

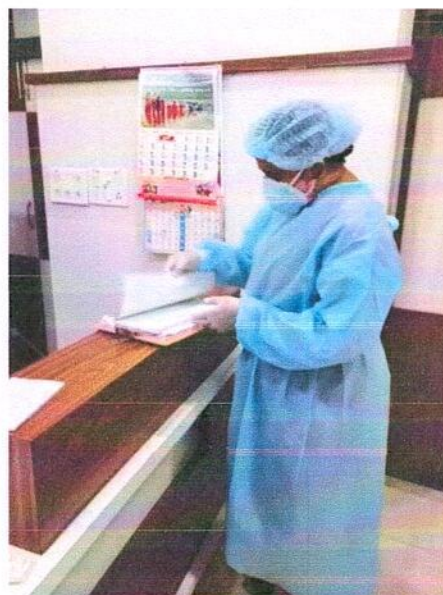

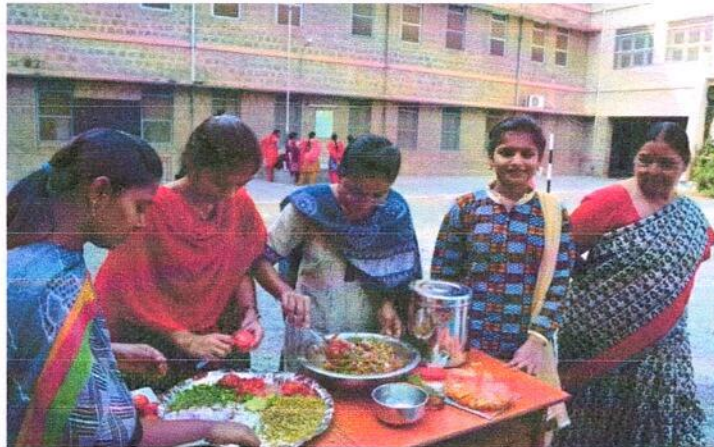
## Solidarity day

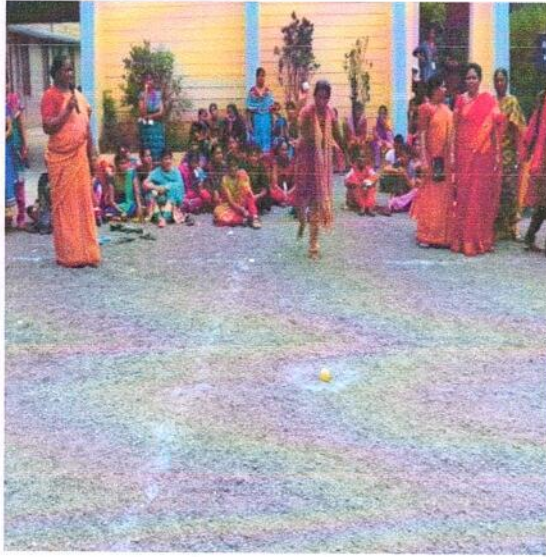

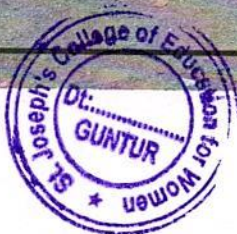
