Founder's Day

St. Joseph's College of Education for women, Guntur celebrated the feast of Saint Mathias Wolf as Founder's Day on 31-10-2022. He was the Saint who found the congregation of JMJ. To give glimpses of his life, a power point presentation was given through which we learnt to a great deal.

Mathias was born to Mathias Wolff and Anna Maria Zenner on 6th March 1779 in Die Kirk; He was brought up in an atmosphere of 'Kindness always and severity when necessary. Later Mathias was ordained as a Diocesan Priest in 1802 and totally dedicated himself to God for serving the people. The impact of French revolution affected him adversely. It moved and prompted Fr. Mathias to take some initiatives towards education of the girls. He thought of encouraging willing girls to join hands to bring the change in the society. Thus, Fr. Mathias Wolff decided to start a woman's congregation to educate the poor girls and to reach out to those in need.

Thee first three girls he started with were Maria Stichters, Sophie Miltner and Lubuina van Elck He got them trained, and theyprofessedas catholic Nuns and later a new Congregation for Women was founded on 29th July 1822, in Amersfoort, and named it as the Society of Jesus Mary Joseph (JMJ). The JMJ Congregation is rendering a great deal of service both nationally and internationally in various fields of which Education, Health and Social service being the prominent ones.

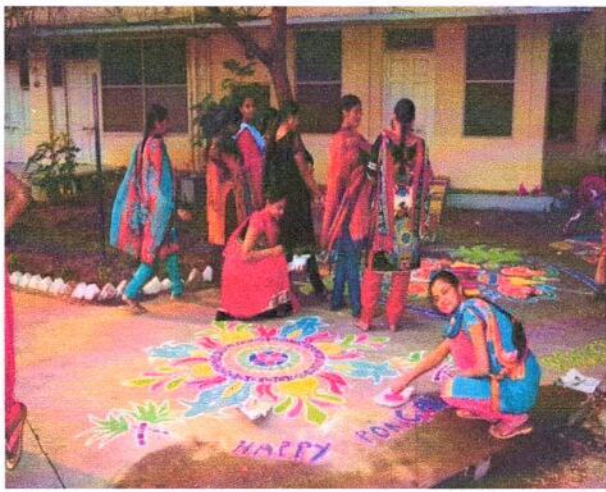

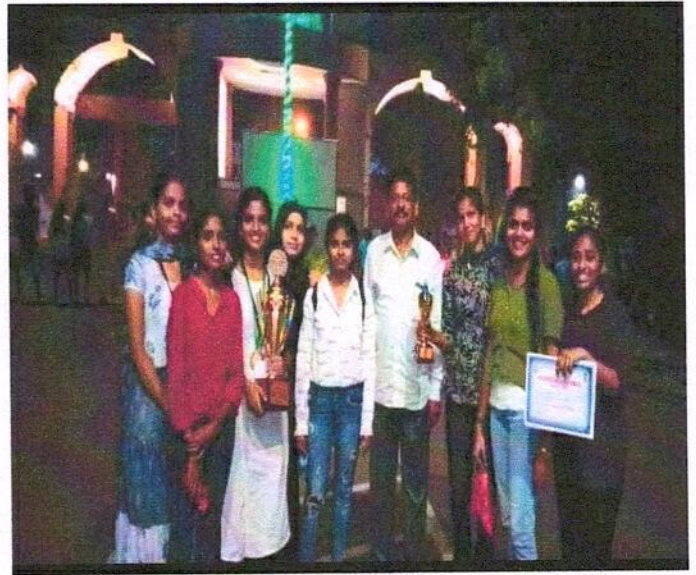

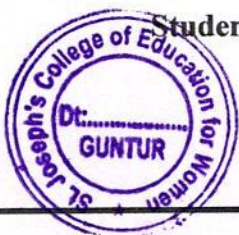

Founders Day

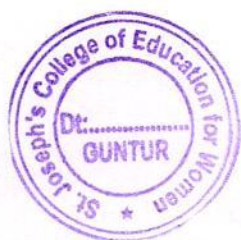

Mathias was born to Mathias Wolff and Anna Maria Zenner on 6th March 1779 in Die Kirk; He was brought up in an atmosphere of 'Kindness always and severity when necessary. Later Mathias was ordained as a Diocesan Priest in 1802 and totally dedicating himself to God in the service of others. The impact of French revolution affected him adversely. It moved and prompted Fr. Mathias to take some initiatives towards Education of the girls. So, he thought of encouraging willing girls to join hands to bring the change in the society. Thus, Fr. 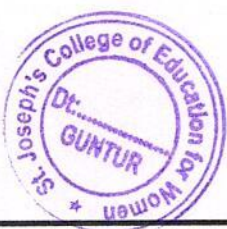

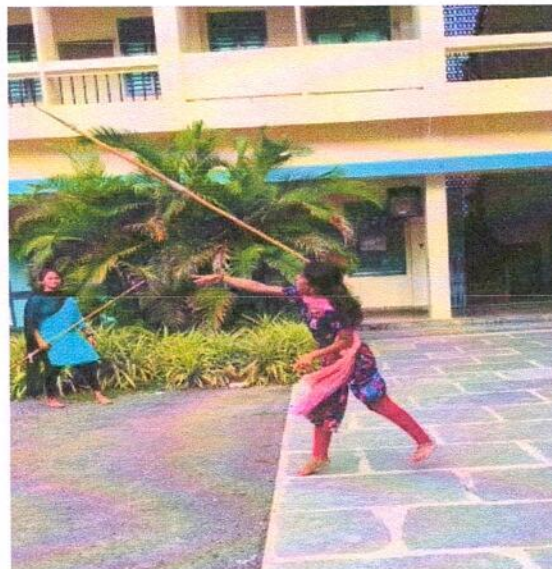

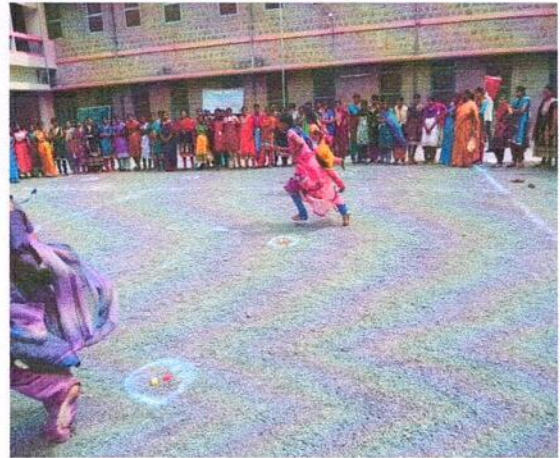

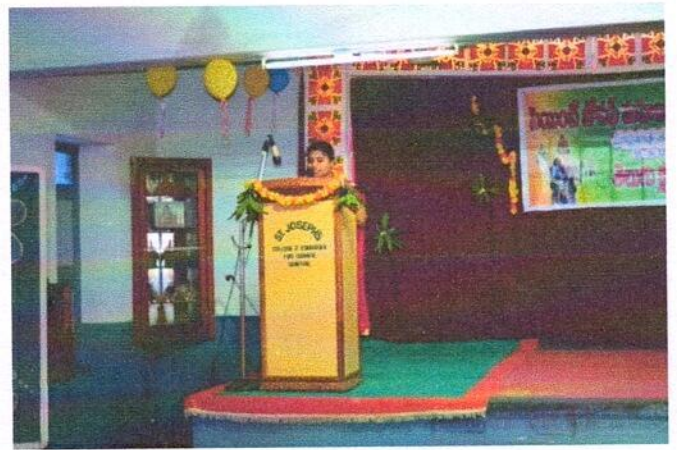
