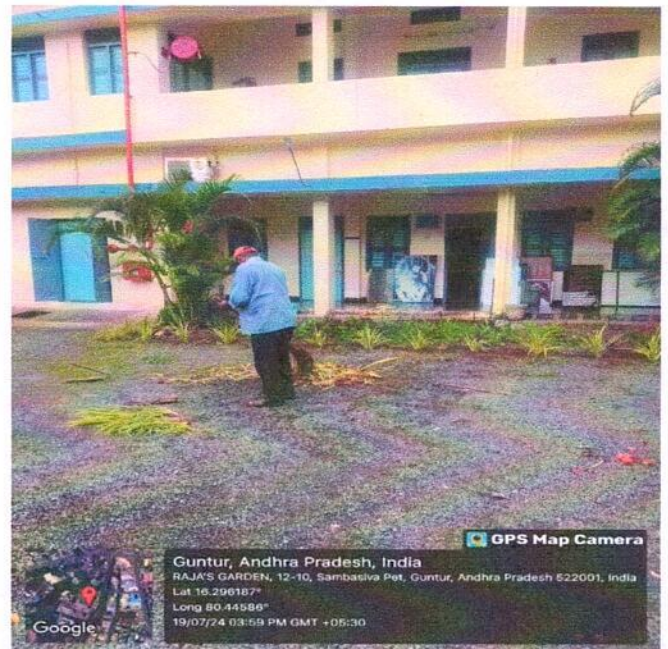

- Banning of single use of plastic and thermocoal plates and also encourage to use steal boxes and bottles

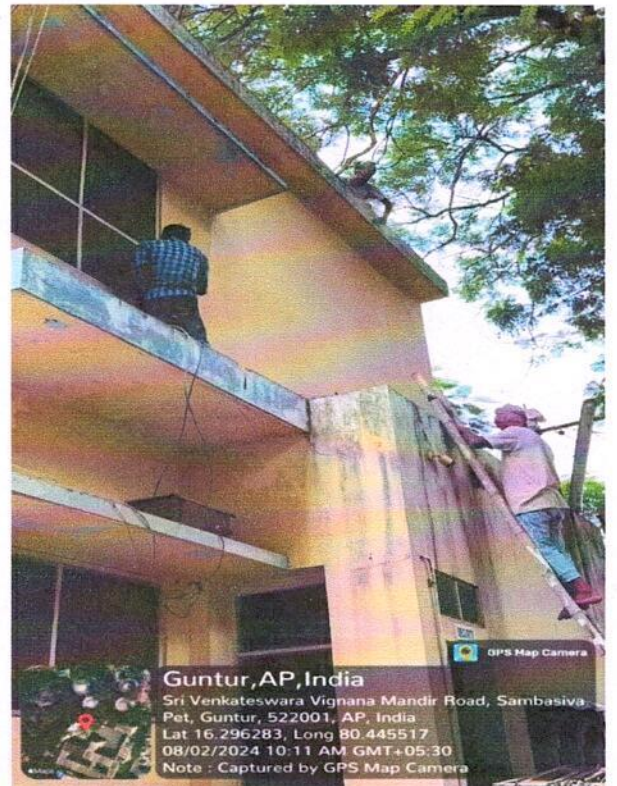
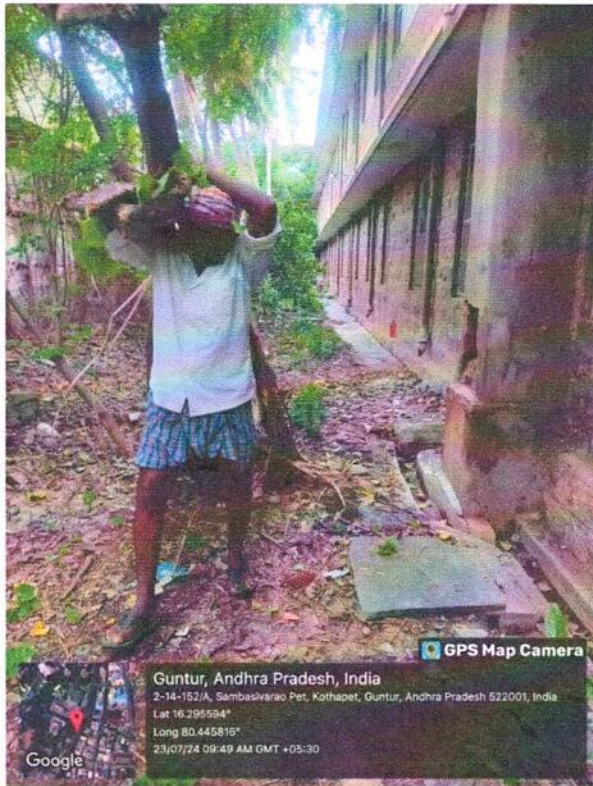

## Report on Swachh Bharat programme at St. Joseph's College of Education for Women, Guntur

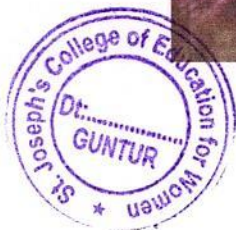
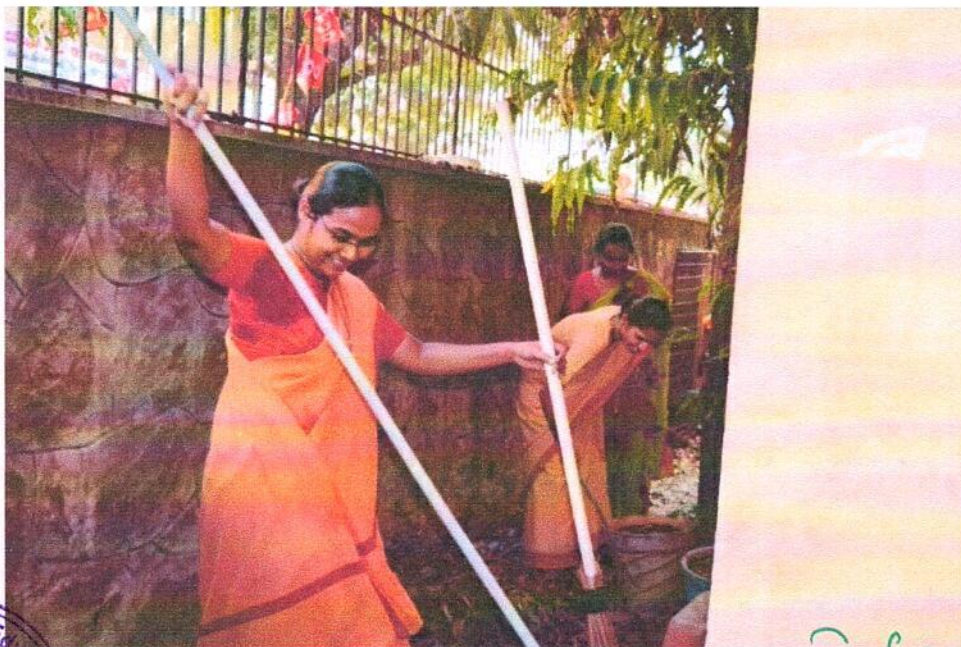

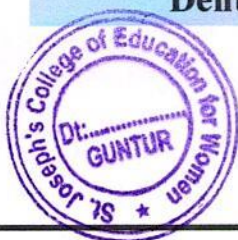


## Awareness Campaign on Oral Hygiene

**Paperless operations-**we have a developed ERP System for all academics and administrative Activities to minimize paper usage. This includes online admission-learning platforms and digital record keeping

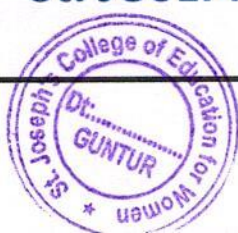
