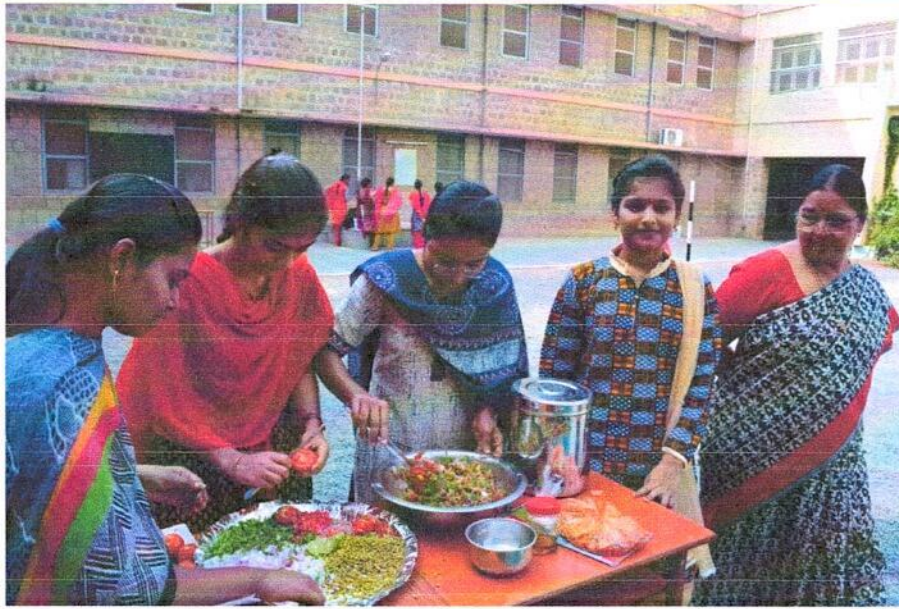
Solidarity day

Visiting to Old Age Homes

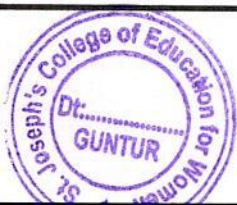
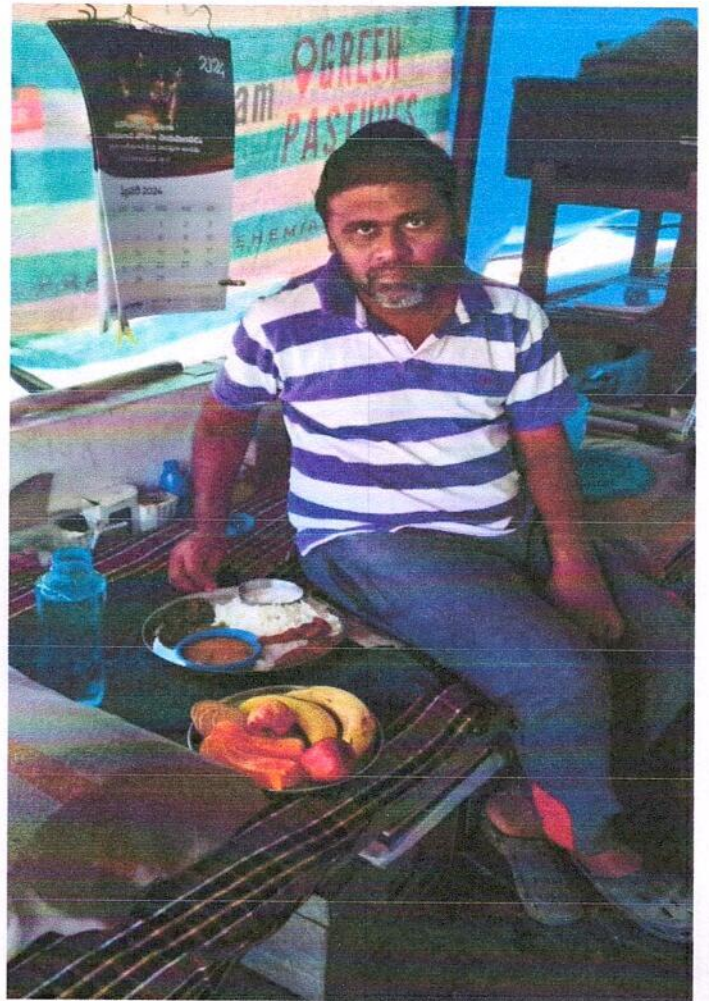
