Activities Undertaken During Epidemic COVID -19

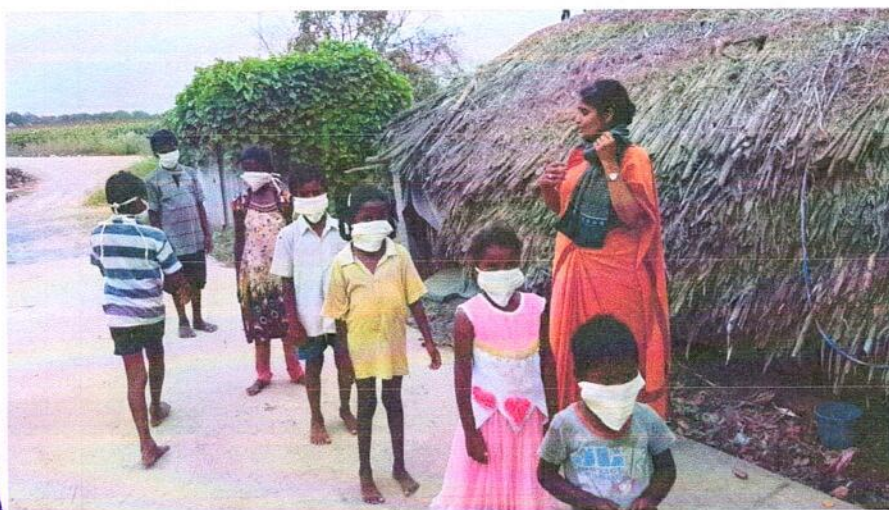
