Student Satisfaction Survey - A Report

2017-18

A survey had been conducted on students about their satisfaction regarding their college experience by the St Joseph's College of Education. The topics covered in the survey include learning experiences by the student teachers in academics, co-curricular activities, art and craft and other learning resource like library, hostel environment and group activities. The students were asked about their personal experiences and the amount of satisfaction they achieved through their experiences when they were a part of college. Their feedback was also collected to improve the standards, where there existed lapses.

The report was collected through questionnaires from all the student teachers and students enrolled for M.Ed.

Following points are expressed as student's comprehensive experiences at St Joseph's College of education.

- About 95% of the students expressed that they felt very much satisfied by the teaching of faculty .
- About 90% of the students expressed satisfaction regarding the methodologies used by the faculty.
- About 50% of the students expressed satisfaction regarding college environmental and rules and regulations of the administration.
- About 70% of the students expressed satisfaction regarding the drinking water facilities (reverse osmosis) and cleanliness maintained in the college premises.
- About 90% of the students expressed satisfaction about the pattern of assessment and the faculty approach.

Taking into consideration each and every response, the faults can be reduced to the fourth coming batch of new students and help improve their levels of satisfaction in learning.
