A survey was conducted by the St Joseph's College of Education with regard to the satisfaction of students in relation to their college experience. Almost all the topics from academics to all other sources of learning were included in the survey conducted through questionnaire. The comments from the students regarding their personal experiences help enhance the prevailing conditions in the college atmosphere. The changes that are going to take place would certainly help for the upcoming batches to improve their standards of learning.

Data was collected from M. Ed students and student teachers through questionnaires as part of the survey.

The following are the highlighted points of the survey.

- About 90% of the students expressed utmost satisfaction regarding discipline and dress code of the college.
- About 95% of the students expressed the fullest satisfaction regarding the cooperation of the teachers in learning new concepts and theories.
- About 75% of the students expressed their satisfaction in improving their psychological well being through practice of yoga and meditation.
- About 80% of the students expressed satisfaction for being a part of learning through practical and project methods.

Individual responses are taken into consideration for the changes to be brought about in the system for the upcoming batches. Satisfaction would certainly improve by adopting changes.
