Student Satisfaction Survey - A Report

A survey was conducted by the St Joseph's College of Education on their students using questionnaires in relation to their experience in college. The survey helps understand the adjustment and satisfaction levels of the students soon after pandemic. The survey stated that 70% of the students were ready to take up new tasks and is physically present in the college while 30% of the students are interested to attend classes online. Those 30% of the students were motivated by the teachers to understand the real life situations and forthcoming situations and are made to learn and understand how to handle the situations being teachers. The students teachers expressed joy and happiness for their physical presence in college after a long gap. Both teachers and students are ready to welcome innovative methods into their teaching learning process.

The following are the highlighted points of the survey.

- About 95% of the students expressed satisfaction regarding their physical presence in the college.
- About 90% of the students expressed their satisfaction regarding the new rules and conditions established by the administration to have a check on the pandemic. (Wearing masks, washing hands thoroughly, Maintaining distance and so on...)
- About 90% of the students expressed their satisfaction regarding the new rules put forward in the hostel. (To avoid close contact with others, to maintain things of their own individually, to maintain cleanliness in the hostel premises and so on...)
- About 95% of the students expressed their satisfaction regarding the teaching faculty in handling the situations.
